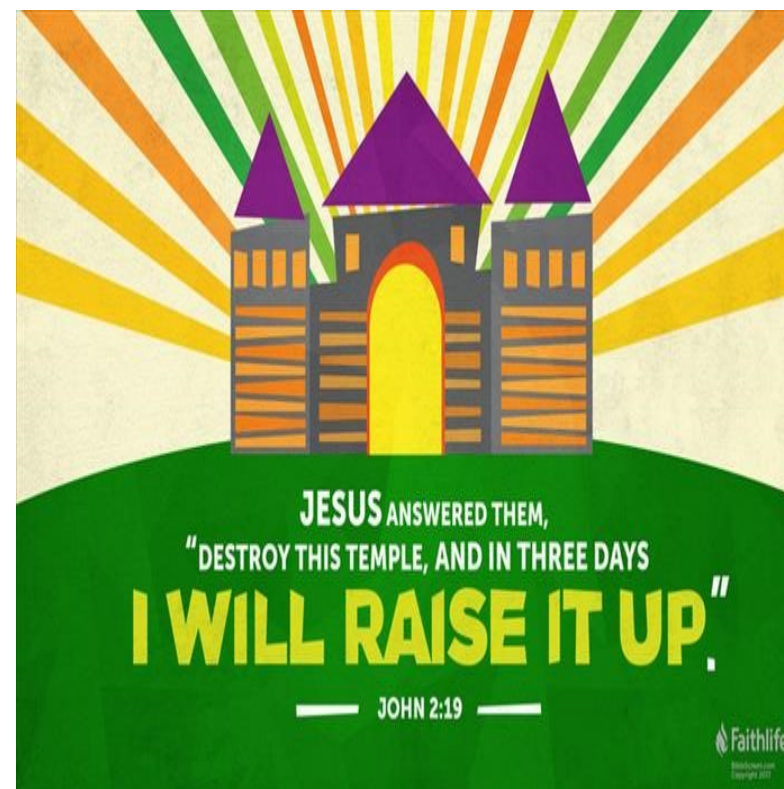

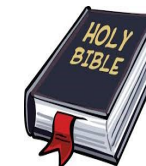

After the resurrection, his disciples looked back on this day and realised that Jesus was the temple and he did return. How do we believe without the disciples' first-hand experience? Where do we experience the resurrection?

Heavenly Lord, help us to follow you. Let our words and actions speak to all the nations, that they may come to walk with you in the resurrected body of Christ.
